

OPERATION FOXTROT (Johnny)

24 April, 1945

Pinpoint is D-075935 (Sheet Y5), 2 km.S. of Neeselwang, on the road from Wertach to Fussen.

Stage I. Uffz. [REDACTED] of the 2/1210 VGR is on the way from Reserve-Lazarett Kempton to his troop, part of the 256 VGD, which is stationed near Passau. The Dienstreisechein which the hospital has given him entitles him to 48 hours leave in Innsbruck on the way. His route is therefore Fussen-Innsbruck-St. Johann-Salzburg. (See Hitide #205 for OB.)

Stage II. In Salzburg he hides these papers and reappears as Uffz. [REDACTED] of the 1139 VGR, formerly of the Luftwaffe. As such, he has been discharged by the LU-Kur Lazarett 2/KII at Bad Gastein, after being treated for #22 (gallbladder infection), to receive report at the Bahnhofswachoffizier Regensburg for duty with his troop, 2% of which is 41497C. (See Hitide 205; this unit was near Augsburg, 175 Km. West, but is the nearest for which we have FFN).

From Salzburg he will follow the route directly by Neu-Gaiting-Landshut-Regensburg. In case Regensburg is taken, he can use the blank Marschbefehle to get himself through the lines.
