MEETING WITH MAJOR BERNARD
12 rue Haerder - Strasbourg

DAILY REPORT #1

17 December 1944

Major Bernard stated that, while he was expecting a number of addresses of safe houses in Germany, he had nothing definite as yet. Towns under consideration are:

HEIDELBERG, close to Mannheim,
OFFENBURG,
SCHWETTINGEN, south of Stuttgart,
TODTMOOS, in Southern Germany, NE of Basel.

There is a possibility of making drops. Bernard has to obtain photos of the area, houses, church emplacements, etc., also safe houses. Bernard believes that through Capt. DUNGLER it would be possible to have these emplacements checked without sending an agent for that purpose.

At SACKINGEN in Germany close to the Swiss border only a few miles from STEIN in Switzerland, there is a safe house.

Bernard has promised to communicate the names and addresses at our next meeting on the 18th inst. As regards [REDACTED] he was unable to contact him at LUTZHOUS near SCHIRMECK on the 16th inst. DUNGLER is believed to be in Mulhouse, and we have been given a letter for him at 29 Grand Rue at Mulhouse. We will try to see him at Mulhouse on our next trip there.

As regards the Gestapo man Mulhouse, Bernard now says that he never met the man and that he is unable to contact him for the moment because the intermediary Mr. R. is not at present at Mulhouse.

GERARD was sent North on mission to obtain information on PALATINAT following a request from Lt. Carre, 7th Army. He is expected back on the 19th inst.

We had an appointment this morning with Mr. COLLS of C.I.C. for the interrogation of a German engineer married to an Alsatian girl and who recently returned from Bratislava. We took this party in charge with the idea of turning him over to CSDIC, in case he can not be used as a potential agent (see special Intelligence Report after interrogation of subject).

Our next appointment with Bernard is on Monday 19th at 7 PM.
