The following message for Dr. Kissinger from Ambassador Farland was received this morning, 22 November:

"Foll for Dr. Henry Kissinger from Ambassador Farland:

"1. My ODRP has received from SecDef (161456Z Nov 1971) communication to effect that DSAA will make a definitive decision by 24 Dec. on 300 armored personnel carriers which Pakistan had purchased under one-time exception to military supply agreement. Copy of message went to Diate.

New Delhi has suddenly become aware of APC contract and that qte first items may now be coming off the production line unqte. It is my guess SecDef's message was qte bootlegged unqte to New Delhi. New Delhi's message strongly prophesies that information will come to public attention qte in one form or another unqte. This is to be assumed since Embassy New Delhi has notoriously leaked classified information.

- "3. On Nov. 2 Yahya alluded to APC purchase and said that, while he understood no delivery could be made at this time and none was expected, he most certainly wanted qte his APC's unque at some later date when circumstances more propitious.
- "4. I strongly urge that a negative decision not rpt not be made at this time, but rather that the decision be held in

continuing abeyance. I press this stance in order to maintain what leverage we have in Islamabad. And I affirm that it is considerable, given the circumstances extant."
