- 1. Attached is a memorandum from Colonel A. E. McCormick to Mr. Krieg, Counselor of Embassy, dated 16 December 1953, entitled "INFOP Loans," photographic records of loans made by INFOP, and a carbon copy of a sheet entitled "Explanatory Notes to Accompany Charts Indicating Partial List of Loans Granted by INFOP During 1953." Also attached is a very rough draft of notes and data obtained from the files of the Guatemala Station concerning various individuals to whom loans were made during the indicated period. These typewritten notes were prepared by Adrian B. KIDWELL of the Guatemala Station.
- 2. It is desired to point out that these records might be usable for KUGCWN purposes; i.e., exposing the identity of persons who have borrowed money from INFOP. It must be realized, however, that the complete records must not be published nor should any entire individual sheet thereof be published because to do so would jeopardize the sources of the Military Attache. It may be possible, however, to use in connection with the KUGCWN radio broadcasts or in publications, data gleaned from these records, that is, exposing individual persons on occasions. It would be a serious mistake, in my opinion, to ever expose the documents themselves.
- 3. I believe that the Military Attache, Colonel McCormick, has another copy of these documents, but the ones attached are those that were intended for the Embassy files and they must, of course, be returned. It is requested that photographs be made at LINCOLN of all of the attached documents including the typewritten notes and thereafter all of these documents be sent to Guatemala Station in order that we may retain the notes prepared by KIDWELL and return the memorandum from Colonel McCormick to Mr. Krieg and the related documents to the Embassy files. It will be appreciated if attention can be given to this and the documents returned in the next pouch.

EXPLANATORY NOTES TO ACCOMPANY CHARTS INDICATING PARTIAL LIST OF LOANS GRANTED BY INFOP DURING 1953

Attached is a partial list of persons receiving loans Nacional of \$3,000 or more from the Instituto/Fomento de la Produccion (INFOP) during the period 3 January - 7 November 1953, showing the action taken on the loans. The term "retirada" means that the loan was approved by INFOP too late to be of use to the applicant, who therefore refused it. "Pendiente resolucion de la G.G." indicates that approval of the loan is pending action by the Gerente General.

General terms for INFOP loans are that the individual must possess assets equivalent to at least 1/3 the value of the loan and that the loan must be repaid over a three-year period in annual payments of 1/3 the value of the loan. In the majority of cases payments are overdue, and in the cases of those influential in the present Administration repayment is almost entirely dependent upon the individual.

A check of the files reveals the following information concerning individuals who are included on the list:

Salvador ABULARACH - Treasurer of Guatemalan Society of Authors and Composers of Music, founded in 1951 (February). Reported in April 1953 to be planning to import Russian films in partnership with a Mexican theater owner.

Juan Antonio ACEVEDO Juarez - Ex-National Deputy; member pro-

government Partido Nacional Renovacion (RN).

Jacobo ARBENZ Guzman - President of Guatemala.

- Mariano AREVALO Bermejo Brother of ex-president of Guatemala, Juan Jose AREVALO Bermejo; former administrator of National Fincas; occasional participant in "peace" movement.
- Francisco BARILLAS Mejia Member of Executive Directorate of INFOP; manager of ARBENZ' finca "El Cajon". In May 1953 it was reported that Antonio VILANOVA, Carlos BRACAMONTE, Francisco MORAZAN and Francisco BARILLAS had purchased a finca southwest of Escuintla. It was suspected at the time that they may have been responsible for a wave of burnings and lootings in that area which caused the selling price of fincas in that area to be substantially lowered.
- Carlos A. BRACAMONTE Morales Protege of ARBENZ; Caribbean Legion member; employed in Private Secretariat of the Presidency; implicated in July 1949 in the assassination of the Armed Forces Colonel Francisco Javier ARANA.
- Oscar CALDERON Ayala One Oscar CALDERON of Guatemala City (not known if identical) listed in 1952 as a member of the railroad union SAMF and possible communist.
- Alonso CASTRO Conde Member of Political Commission of progovernment Partido de la Revolucion Guatemalteca (PRG); member of Executive Directorate of INFOP.
- Carlos CHEESMAN Mollinedo One Carlos or Frank CHEESMAN reported in August 1949 to be engaged in arms smuggling.
- Bartolome COSTA-AMIC Spanish political refugee; vice-president of board of directors of Spanish Republican Center; chief of printing office of Ministry of Public Education; listed as a "Socialist".
- Hector A. CRUZ Quintana Member of disciplinary commission of PRG; former Sub-Secretary of Agriculture.
- Jorge GARCIA Granados Lawyer; presidential candidate against ARBENZ; reported to be a member of the Communist Party of Mexico; ex-secretary to Vicente LOMBARDO Toledano.
- Raul GARCIA Granados Son of Jorge GARCIA Granados; reported to be involved in Caribbean revolutionary activities.

Felipe Antonio GIRON - Guatemalan Army Officer; ex-director of the Guardia Civil.

Luis A. GIRON - Chief of Guatemalan Air Force.

Oscar GIRON Perrone - Guatemalan Army Officer.

Humberto GONZALEZ Juarez - Secretary General of the Presidency.

Jose Ruben GONZALEZ Sigue - Guatemalan Army Officer; ex-Military Attache to Mexico.

GUATEPLAST - Local company handling plastics and under the direction of the partnership of Milos BARTL and Jorge RYBAR, both of Czechoslovakia. RYBAR has applied for Guatemalan citizenship.

Alberto HERRARTE - former Guatemalan Minister to Costa Rica.

Elfego H. MONZON - Ex-Chief of Staff of Guatemalan Army; presently, Minister of State without Portfolio; believed anti-Communist.

Francisco MORAZON - Honduran exile; private secretary in the Presidency; close associate of President ARBENZ; implicated in the ARANA assassination.

Ricardo RAMIREZ - One Ricardo RAMIREZ (not known if identical) is Secretary General of the pro-communist Frente Universitario Democratico (FUD) and active in the "peace" movement.

Humberto SOLARES Godoy - Guatemalan Army officer; ex-director of Military Hospital; in 1953, head of the Army Commissary department; sent to U.S. in November 1953 on official mission for the Guatemalan Government, type unstated.

Cesar Gustavo SOLIS Dardon - One Cesar G. SOLIS (not known if identical) was Secretary General of the Presidency in 1951.

Antonio VILANOVA Castro - Brother of Maria VILANOVA de Arbenz, wife of the president of Guatemala.
