SUBJECT : Security Considerations for PBSUCCESS

1. In a conversation between the writer and [] Jan 5 February, [] made the observation that to the best of his knowledge, none of the persons now on the T/O for Lincoln and presently at Lincoln have had their personnel files "blocked off" so that outside checks with the Agency personnel office would not reveal their present connections with the Agency. He suggested that I&S personnel connected with PBSUCCESS matters would be willing to have this done on a priority basis to assure maximum security for PBSUCCESS personnel and operations.
2. While in [] office on 8 February 1954 on another matter, she mentioned her concern about the security of personnel assigned to Lincoln because in some cases persons at Lincoln had not gone through Central Processing which would normally take care of "blocking off" their files (according to the writer's understanding of her remarks.)
3. While the writer cannot vouch for the accuracy of the fact that personnel files have in fact not been "blocked off," the above is furnished for your information.
