MEMORANDUM FOR: The Record

SUBJECT : Labor Program PBSUCCESS

1. Upon the suggestion of CPP the proposed labor program for PBSUCCESS was discussed with Messrs. [ ] and Meyer of the IOD.

2. No basic objections were raised as to WH proceeding on the development of labor assets in Mexico as outlined in the program. Some concern was manifested, however, that KUBARK might cross paths with the [ ] which has recently concerned itself with the situation in WSBURNT.

3. Mr. Braden believed that he could find out to a degree what the [ ] was doing about the WSBURNT situation. In addition Mr. [ ] thought it advisable to find out what actions Mr. Dulles had taken or plans to take prior to implementing any program through PBPRIME labor.

4. Church contacts that might be utilized to supplement the PBSUCCESS KUGOWN program was discussed. The undersigned suggested that WH ideas on the subject with a suggested course of action be presented to Messrs. [ ] and Meyer for their consideration and action. Approval is requested for this action.
