DISCUSSION:

Collins opened the discussion by stating that as a result of his survey of all Naval facilities in only the following were immediately available for the purposes of PBSUCCESS:

The space indicated in A. above would be compartmented and at the present would be the only activity within the building which is located in the general billets area at The matter of communications was considered resolved although special lines would have to be installed from the Base Communications Building. These quarters would be available immediately. Detailed questions pertaining to security, passes for civilians, utilities and office equipment would have to be resolved directly with the CG at the Base.

DECISIONS: A. Cmdr. Collins was requested to secure area A. above pending formalization of request;

- would arrange necessary formal letter required to formalize this negotiation.
- would refer the matter of communications to for his action, viz. Adm. Ammons.
- Cmdr. Collins would prepare a letter of introduction which would not reveal CTA but would enable him to establish proper rapport with the CG, , to negotiate further details. This letter would be dated on/about 3 December and would be presented personally by to the CG.

COMMENTS: It appears that area A. would be entirely suitable for the requirements of PBSUCCESS and that the problems of security, utilities, housekeeping and communications can all be resolved through the above procedures. The question of billeting staff personnel would have to await personal negotiations with the Base CG. This Base is located approximately
