1. Do you have men who can prepare and distribute propaganda in the Capital and in the towns in which government troops are located?

How many? Are there enough to insure that when we need to make propaganda, we can?

In which cities?

Do you have men who have prepared propaganda or are now employed to prepare propaganda?

2. What facilities do you have in the Capital city to prepare and distribute propaganda? What plans do you have for the distribution of propaganda? How many men, in which you have confidence, are at your service in the Capital? We need a complete study.
3. We need a list of Army personell. We plan to make divisions; prepare character assassinations and other operations to divide the official forces of the Army. For this reason, we need everything possible on the character of each important officer. Also a list of oficiales loyal to our cause is needed.
4. As there are many dangers in distributing large propaganda as posters, fliers, and other types of propaganda in quantity, we believe that the best things to do is create propaganda in the form of rumors - a rumor net. For this reason, we need a list of the potential in order to form a group in each important place - especially in the Capital. Also, we need news periodically, which will tell of the circulating rumors, and the progress in the development of the rumor net.
5. We have an idea on how to discover a communist "cell" in one of the Central American countries, full of documents, handbills, posters, and any other evidence that we need to prove to the world that the Communists in their country are preparing a revolution for the glory of the Soviet Union - and are also preparing a revolution or a subversion of the governments of other Latin American countries. Possibly, we can obtain some true documents that we can copy, but if this is not possible we will have to fabricate the documents and other necessary evidence.

What do you think of the idea?

Can you or some of your friends produce the necessary evidence?

6. We need a list of themes to cause discontent.
7. What do you think of adhesive fliers which will have the symbol of our struggle on them? How many do you want?

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8. We know that probably the most important actions corresponding to propaganda are those directed to individuals, special groups, but most of these operations need personal direction. Will you be the director?
9. What type of a psychological campaign do you want to launch? What help do you need? There are many operations of propaganda which do not require a great amount of materials, as: a man with a few fliers or an anonymous letter directed to the target - rumors; handbills, sent by mail - a radio within the country and out of the country, communication by telephone.
10. We are interested in photographs of conditions within the country to send to contacts in other countries for publication. Do you have cameras to fulfill this necessity? If not, what do you need?
11. We are thinking of various plans to distract the Communists, like demonstrations, picnics, or some other diversion to create confusion and confound the Army up to the Day of Salvation. Do you have any ideas?
12. What do you need? Printing equipment; paper; radio?
13. We want all your suggestions for the total campaign, and your ideas on special operations.
14. Do you have enough artists to make pamphlets, etc? If not, we have facilities to make them. Also, we have facilities to reproduce documents, etc.
15. Who are your contacts among the labor leaders in your country? - The organizations to which these men belong? Where are they? Especially, do they have contact with Arturo Morales Cubas?
16. What possibilities are there for sporadic or short strike actions on a local plane?
17. Are there student contacts in the country?
18. In the July issue of the BOLETIN DEL CEUSAGE part of the letter of the AFofL to the Comité de Estudiantes Universitarios Anticomunistas appeared. Is direct or indirect contact maintained between your group and the ORIT, AFofL or any other free worker's organization?
