1. RNDINDLE DEPARTED UNDER SAFE CONDUCT FOR HONDURAS BY AIR 13 APR. SENT WORD TO [ ] THROUGH INTERMEDIARY PRIOR TO TAKING ASYLUM 8 APR. PLANNED SPEND ONE DAY HONDURAS, ABOUT ONE WEEK SALVADOR THEN PROCEED U.S. ASKED THAT [ ] TRY ARRANGE FINANCIAL HELP FOR HIM.

2. WHILE HIS FUTURE USEFULNESS TO ESPLANADE QUESTIONABLE BECAUSE CAN NOT RETURN IN FORESEEABLE FUTURE WE FEEL AT LEAST MODERATE FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE DESIRABLE CONSIDERING POSSIBLE PBFORTUNE USEFULNESS; DESIRE HE NOT LOSE INTEREST; DESIRE HE CONTINUE FAVORABLE ATTITUDE TOWARD [ ] FOR SECURITY REASONS; PROBABLE USEFULNESS IN NEW GOVERNMENT IN EVENT SUCCESSFUL REVOLUTION.

3. HE WILL GIVE CREDIT TO [ ] IF ADVISED ASSISTANCE ARRANGED BY "HIS OILMAN FRIEND" WITHOUT MENTIONING NAME.

4. HQS INSTRUCTIONS REQUESTED. [ ] COULD PROBABLY CONTACT HIM SALVADOR IF DESIRE.
