1. JUMPER EXPECTS [ ] COMING TO CENTRAL AMERICA FROM U.S. THIS WEEK TO CONTACT CALLIGERIS WHILE IN SALVADOR ON PERSONAL BUSINESS. JUMPER EVAL B-3.

2. REASONS [ ] DESIRES CONTACT CALLIGERIS UNKNOWN EXCEPT DESIRES WARN HIM TOO LITTLE SECURITY IN GUATEMALA WITH FOLLOWING RUMORS. EVAL B-6.

A. CALLIGERIS WENT TO COLUMBIA TO ARRANGE NAVAL BLOCKADE OF PORTS SAN JOSE AND PUERTO BARRIOS.

B. ANTI-COMMIE PURCHASED ARMS LAST YEAR THROUGH U.S. ARMY COLONEL AND MAJOR AS RESULT MEETING IN OAXACA MEXICO. ARMS U.S. MANUFACTURE FROM EUROPE WITH IDENTITY FILED OFF.

C. THREE DIFFERENT ANTI-COMMIE EMISSARIES HAVE VISITED GEN TRUJILLO AND EACH HAVE BEEN PROMISED FULL SUPPORT AS THE NEXT PRESIDENT OF GUATEMALA, RESULTING IN LACK UNITY AMONG ANTI-COMMIE
