Guatemalan propaganda introduced into El Salvador caused a deterioration in relations between the two countries, to joy of subject.

CASTILLO Armos was reported planning on uniting with subject, who is supposedly financed by TRUJILLO of the Dominican Republic.

Of the three groups preparing for a revolution in Guatemala, that led by the Asociacion General de agricultores reportedly has the best chance for success. Subject is leader of another group composed of the old UBICO Liberal Party. One Ovidio PIVARAL reportedly has contributed \$10,000 to the group and it has 2 airplanes.

15 Dec 50

In a letter written by a suspected Communist, subject was described as representing pure tradition, the UBICO group, the Catholic Church, colonial tradition, the hegemony of millionaire and aristocratic families.

23 Nov 53

Subject and Guillermo PUTZEYS wrote REMON of Panama requesting aid in overthrowing the present Guatemalan government.

Subject sent list of approximately 550 Guatemalan Communists to the Minister of Foreign Relations of Panama.

24 Dec 52

Subject described as an extreme rightist, who is cooperating with RUFUS, who desires to utilize his assistance, but to maintain him in a neutral category.

24 Jan 51

Subject in conversation with U.S. Embassy employee in Guatemala mentioned a LIPSHUTZ of Chile, whom he met once in London. He is believed identical with Prof. Alejandro LIPSCHUTZ Friedman, a radiologist and ardent Communist of Chile.

12 July 50

On 14 March 1950 the above conversation occurred. Subject stated he met LIPSCHUTZ at a Soviet Embassy reception in London on 14 March 1947. LIPSCHUTZ assumed that subject was in sympathy with the AREVALO regime and greeted him with clenched fist salute and stated that he was a close friend of AREVALO.

28 July 53

Talk of a coalition among Carlos CASTILLO Armas, Juan CORDOVA Cerra and subject.

29 Dec 50

Subject, defeated presidential candidate, left Guatemala for El Salvador on 13 December 1950.

30 Nov 51

Subject alleged to be involved in plot to overthrow the Guatemalan government.

28 Nov 51

Guatemalan G-2 was reported to have sent agents to El Salvador to check on possible subversive activities of subject and Luis CORONADO Lira.

30 Oct 52

An agent of General PINEDA of Honduras was stationed in El Salvador to report on the revolutionary activities of subject.
