SUBJEC REFSPECTED 198, 9 March 1954; GUAT 446, 1 May (not sent to Tegucigalpa).

1. It is again requested that you ask CALLIGERIS to clarify the position of the subject with reference to SYNCARP. You have still not made clear the nature of his connection with the CALLIGERIS organization, and it is important that we have this information.

2. In a communication received from Guatemala on 1 May 1954 it was stated that the subject had said that SEMANTIC had returned to Guatemala and that this represented another example of bungling on the part of the CALLIGERIS organization. Despite instructions issued to the subject he has again violated security. It is not known how he received the information concerning SEMANTIC.

3. It is reported that the subject plans on going to Mexico City on 30 April to attend a United Nations meeting, and that he will remain there for approximately one week. It is suggested that CALLIGERIS make arrangements to have this matter discussed with the subject while he is in Mexico City.
