MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD:

At 1134 hours 12 April 1954, I received a call from the overseas operator/Tropical Radio informing me of a call from Washington, D. C. The caller identified himself as Ed (presumed to be []) and asked for [] I told him that the Major was on the other side of the [] He asked me who was speaking and I replied, [] He said, "I got you, []"

Ed then asked me, "At what time did you receive the call from [] telling you to disregard #146049?" I asked him to wait a minute and I checked the MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD written by Major [] re the telephone conversation with [] I then told Ed that the time of the call from [] advising us to disregard #146049 was 1344.

Ed then asked me, "Your time?" I told him, "Your time, same time." He (Ed) asked, "A.M. or P.M.?" I replied, "P.M."

Ed repeated the time as 1344 in the P.M. and then asked me if there was anything he could do for me. I replied, "No."
