- ODEENVY Requirements

The following requirements were submitted by ODEENVY for both PHISTORY and station.

1. Identities of PBPRIME citizens who collaborated, or were associated with BGGYPSYS or BGGYPSYS supporters. Available details regarding the background and activities of such individuals.

2. Information concerning [] espionage operations. The very proximity of WSBURNT to the PBPRIME would indicate a strong possibility of links with [] agents in this country.

3. Evidence that the BGGYPSY Party of PBPRIME has used WSBURNT as a safe haven or any other evidence connected with underground operations of the BGGYPSY Party of PBPRIME.

4. Evidence of correspondence between BGGYPSYS in WSBURNT and individuals in PBPRIME.

5. Evidence of cryptographic material used by BGGYPSYS or espionage agents.

6. The nature of the liaison between the BGGYPSY Party in WSBURNT and BGGYPSY groups in other countries.

7. Pertinent data concerning any specialized training on the part of the BGGYPSYS in the fields of sabotage, riot instigation, and the manufacture and use of arms and ammunition.

8. Any data concerning operational methods and techniques of [] espionage agents.
