REF:

1. Congressman HILLINGS, chairman subcommittee of house committee on communist aggression, and congressman DODD, committee member, will arrive about September one to study findings of GUAT Govt on communist aggression. They may be preceded by committee consultant, Patrick MCMAHON, journalist by Profession, (FYI only, MCMAHON ALLEGES CLOSE friendship with PEURIFOY but is not HILLINGS selection. Approach by MCMAHON who sometimes uses old White House press card should be referred to JMBLUG for decision. Contact with MCMAHON may be unavoidable but should be cautious and should not reveal KUBARK idents. HILLINGS has expressed understanding attitude and does not plan holding hearings outside U.S. but may seek assistance GUAT government to supply witnesses for U.S. hearings. HILLINGS talk with GUAT ambassador WASHINGTON, promised full cooperation his govt, including access to documents, atrocities and Attorney General complaint list.

2. Headquarters in touch with both committee chairman KIRSTEN and HILLINGS, assisting them in obtaining documentation in order reduce necessity of their making great effort in field.

3. HQS proposed that MYLKES be sole KUBARK liaison in his role

HILLINGS informed of MYLKES true identity and work and that MYLKES will contact him direct on arrival.

HILLINGS had intel experience during war and is believed responsive to security. Current thinking here is that it is not necessary to impose BNNISTER or other KUBARK personnel, since no covert operational info is to be passed to HILLINGS or associates.

4. Please discuss foregoing with JMBLUG and advise his reactions. Also advise HQS of HILLINGS itinerary on leaving GUAT when congressman informs you.
