"6. Guatemala.

The status report had an item stating that "the new Under Secretary of Foreign Relations for Guatemala has asked whether shipping facilities exist from U. S. to USSR for the purpose of sending Communist and Moscow agents to the Soviet." The DCI mentioned this item and said that if such a disposal is feasible and the only difficulty was how to finance the transportation, he would be prepared to finance it. Apparently the matter was reported in a cable from the Ambassador in Guatemala to the State Department. Some doubt was expressed as to whether such a deal could be worked out. If it could be worked out, the view was expressed that the use of a Guatemalan vessel, or at least one from Central America, would be desirable."
