SUBJECT

: Stopping Payment of \$300,00 Transferred

28 June by Guatemalan Government

- 1. A recent report from a Los Angeles bank indicates that on 28 June it was ordered by Banco de Guatemala to transfer \$300,000 of Guatemalan Government funds to a Swiss Bank (Union Banque de Suisse). It could very well be that other banks holding Guatemalan funds have recently been ordered to transfer funds also.
- 2. June 28 was the day that Diaz was in charge and he may have been responsible for ordering the transaction, or it might have been carried over from an Arbenz order. In any case, the new government of Guatemala might send telegrams to the Swiss Bank and any other banks holding Guatemalan Government funds, telling them to stop further transfer of those funds, inasmuch as it wants to review committments for payments of such sums of money.
- 3. It is recommended that the Guatemalan Government be advised to stop transferral of money, especially by the Swiss Bank, until review and new orders can be issued by the established government.
