## 1. FOLLOWING FOR JMBLUG FROM HOLLAND:

"ALTHOUGH WE CAN ANTICIPATE PROBLEMS IN OUR RELATIONS WITH COL. CASTILLO ARMAS, AS YOU HAVE AIREADY FORESEEN, IT IS NEVERTHELESS UP TO US TO SEE TO IT THAT (A) CASTILLO IS REASONABLY SATISFIED WITH HIS POSITION AND (B) EFFECTIVE WORKING RELATIONS WITH HIM HE ESTABLISHED AS PROMPTLY AS POSSIBLE. THIS IS IMPORTANT BECAUSE, IN VIEW OF THE SUPPORT WHICH CASTILLO HAS RECEIVED FROM HONDURAS AND NICARAGUA, HE IS IN A POSITION SERIOUSLY POTCOMPETCATE RELATIONS BETWEEN THOSE COUNTRIES AND GUATEMAIA AND HEININEM THOSE COUNTRIES AND OURSELVES SHOULD HE BECOME HOWEVER, IN YOUR DIRECT DEALINGS WITH THE JUNIA MEMBERS DISSATISFIED. TOU MAY INDICATE OUR REASON FOR FAVORING STRONG POSITION FOR CASTILLO MAJ KELLONZIBLE LIES IN THE FACT THAT HE IS THE MAN WICSE MOVEMENT SECRETARIES OVERERROW OF ARBENZ REGIME AND MADE POSSIBLE THE EXPLISION OF THE COMMUNISTS.
