1. The Comité Juvenil Contra la Intervención Extranjera (CJCIE), or Anti-Foreign Intervention Youth Committee, held a meeting on the night of 1 June 1954, during the course of which speeches were made by Augusto CAZALI Avila, of the Frente Universitario Democrático (FUD), and Hector VILLATORO. These followed the general Communist line, attacking the United States for engaging in economic and military imperialism, etc.

2. The directorate of the CJCIE is composed of the following individuals:

President: Alfredo BONATTI
Secretary: Luis SICKAVIZA
Propaganda: Raul SANTACRUZ
Finance: Hector VILLATORO
Public Relations: Fernando VALENZUELA
Acts Secretary: Manuel Antonio SANDOVAL

3. Also present, in addition to the two ^{speakers} operators mentioned in para. 1 above, were: Abel CUENCA, Max SALAZAR, Santiago REYES, Alfonso ORANTEZ, Bernardo ALVARADO Monzón, Marcial MENDEZ Montenegro, Huberto ALVARADO, Raul LEIVA, Otto Raul GONZALEZ, René VALLE, Rafael del BUEN, and approximately 100 other individuals.

4. The following youth organizations had been invited to attend the CJCIE meeting: Alianza de la Juventud Democrática Guatemalteca, Juventud Revolucionaria Guatemalteca, Frente Universitario Democrático, Juventud de Renovación Nacional, Confederación de Estudiantes de Post-Primaria, Juventud del Partido Guatemalteco del Trabajo, Juventud del Grupo Saker-ti, Juventud Ferrocarrilera, Juventud de Alianza Femenina Guatemalteca, Juventud de la Confederación de Trabajadores de Guatemala, and the Sindicato de Trabajadores de la Educación. Source did not state how many of these were actually represented.

1. Field Comment: It is not known how many of these organizations were actually represented at the meeting.
