1. Your paragraph 1: We have noted the changes in your 3 teams. In the meantime you have received our wire #3633 and have been able to act accordingly, we hope.

2. Your paragraph 3. Considering the present situation inside the factory, we consider it most important that you utilize all radio stations in your area to the fullest extent possible. We received today a report from which we quote the following passage which will interest you:

"Reception at 1145 AM of the Ceuage Program via station HRQ at 6150 kilocycles was very good despite interference by harmonics from a government communications station. A technical expert believes that intentional jamming of a legitimate broadcast on an internationally recognized wave length is unlikely. We suggest that scripts prepared by the group should be used as much as possible."

3. As you know we are trying to give you as much guidance and material as possible. Now, however, with the situation changing virtually every day, much depends upon your own ingenuity and resourcefulness. We shall continue to advise you by wire or letter whenever practicable.

4. We have noted the remainder of your report with interest.
