1. Since no reply to the contrary was received to reference prior to the 8 June pouch deadline we are forwarding the SUMMIT recordings.

2. Although all the speeches recorded did not deal specifically with the WSBURNT question, we are forwarding the complete set since most delegates made quotable remarks about the issue, and the tapes can be edited by LINCOLN facilities to show hemisphere backing for the principal WSBURNT "ponencias".

3. Unfortunately, time and staff limitations have made it impossible for this _______ to audit the complete set, and since no record was kept by the recording technicians of the speeches or speakers on each tape, LINCOLN will have to compile the record while editing the tapes. However, all speakers are introduced by the chairman of the sessions, and the task should not prove to be too difficult.

4. The tapes were recorded on a 50-cycle "Ampro" dual-track recorder.
