SPECIFIC Strike Agitators

1. With reference to your request accompanying the list of Communist organizers active in the north coast strike, we have very little information in our files. The name of Celestino CASTRO appeared on a list of Salvadoran Communists. He was stated to be a teacher and at present in Chile. According to information obtained by Honduran police in a raid of October 1953, Jose Antonio FAJARDO is (a tailor in Puerto Cortes and a Communist Party member.)
