SUBJECT: General - Political Action, ERRATIC/CALLIGERIS
Specific - Debriefing JUVIA-2 in re: FT/11

REF: HUL-A-20, FT/11
HUL-A-62

1. The ERRATIC/JUVIA-2 meetings have been reduced in frequency (LINC 733, Para 5-A) and the trend directed more to debriefing of capabilities and assets (LINC 733, Para 5-A, and HUL-A-62 Para 1-F). This has been accomplished in regard personnel aspects by encouraging him to discuss the potential appointees in a new government and enlarging on their background, qualifications, and trustworthiness. Physical capabilities have been elicited by questioning how he would propose materials and men to overthrow the government could be introduced into Guatemala.
2. ERRATIC is thoroughly convinced the only chance for ultimate success lies in cooperation with CALLIGERIS so the mission of HUL-A-62 Para 1-E has been accomplished.
3. ERRATIC has not been informed the LAS is also supporting CALLIGERIS. This information will be imparted only upon specific instructions from LINCOLN.
4. ERRATIC previously asked for []. The smallness of this sum and the associated circumstances of the operation caused it to be regarded as a test of good faith and valid backing. Since it was seemingly within the guidance of HUL-A-62 Para 1-E as well as the authority and allotment of HUL-A-20, task FT/11 it was immediately furnished on the premise that \$2000 immediately produced was tantamount to a larger sum advanced after delay. LINCOLN was immediately advised by [] 0939 Para 4 and ratification requested. ERRATIC was also told, at the time of delivery, that any other sums advanced would have to be cleared by JUVIA-2 through his group.
5. Some security speculations occur to [] as a result of the debriefing, which are advanced for consideration in regard the status of CALLIGERIS:

Debriefing of JUVIA

In re meeting JUVIA-2/ERRATIC on Tuesday, 2 March 1954, evening (Eighth Meeting).

1. ERRATIC stated LANUZA left Guatemala January 14 via PAA arriving in Salvador on the same day. He left Salvador on the 15th for Guatemala via PAA. ERRATIC saw him both days. LANUZA is 174 centimeters tall (5'7") with brown eyes; and, when ERRATIC last saw him, he was in very poor physical condition and gaunt with swollen ankles, sunken eyes and cheeks, and suffering from high blood pressure. He is 52 years old. LANUZA has a finca in Guatemala near the border of Mexico. ERRATIC sends registered mail to Tapachula, Mexico, where LANUZA picks it up, and then recrosses the border into Guatemala where he distributes it.

2. During 23-25 February several people left Guatemala and passed through [] enroute to [] They were drunk and bragged to ERRATIC that CALLIGERIS needed them immediately because he was going to start something big. ERRATIC knows his men well. CALLIGERIS only sufficiently pays his top men but not the underlings. He has the underlings practically on starving wages, and consequently ERRATIC must loan them money whenever he sees them. These men asked for and received small loans from him.

3. Last Sunday Norman Black of the World Bank left Salvador for PEPRINE and with him went his Secretary, Dr. Enrique Lopez HERRARTE. They will be in Washington on April 1. Dr. HERRARTE is an old friend and collaborator of ERRATIC. He is also a contact and source of information in Washington. While in Salvador he spent much time with ERRATIC. He told him if ERRATIC was successful in ousting the Communist Government in Guatemala he would request leave of absence to become Minister of Economics for ERRATIC. HERRARTE is at the moment recruiting loyal, able young men of anti-Communist sentiments now studying, or who have in the past studied, in PEPRINE. His plan is to use these men, or to obtain from them technical cooperation, for the proposed Government. They can be used in subordinate posts since the higher posts should, of course, be filled by more mature, loyal, able men who actively support the movement and jeopardize their lives and fortunes combating Communism. Dr. Lopez HERRARTE's brother, Dr. Marino L. HERRARTE, now in Guatemala, is likewise soliciting assistance of similarly well-qualified young men in that country.

4. The following incidental facts may be pertinent:

- A. Dr. Lopez HERRARTE told ERRATIC that Guillermo TORIELLO, now Minister of Exterior Relations for Guatemala, spread the rumor in Washington, prior to his departure to assume the post, that the Communists would stop their propaganda against the United States when he, TORIELLO, assumed office.

- B. Recently, Dr. Lopez HERRARTE said it is a known fact the Guatemalan Embassy in Washington conferred privately with President Eisenhower and that it was agreed in exchange for removing John Cabot the Guatemalans would cease their campaign against the United States and cooperate at Caracas.
- C. Dr. Lopez HERRARTE also stated in his opinion (Captain) Alfonso MARTINEZ, who is the (head of Departamento Agrario National), had realized all too late what was taking place in the Administration and although he wanted to turn from the Communists, he was in too deep and is now unable to do so. (Note: might be defector prospect).
- D. TORIELLO is a descendant of an Italian soldier of fortune who came to Guatemala. In 1952 he contracted to deliver to the Guatemalan Government 100 tractors. The Government paid one million dollars cash. Actually the tractors are purported to have been pilfered from an ODIORRE dump in North Africa, some of General Clark's old equipment. They were purchased by the TORIELLO group at the ridiculously low price of thirty thousand dollars. His family and henchmen received this profit. He is now reportedly milking the present Government for everything he can.
- E. In regard to the provisional cabinet personnel previously submitted:
1. For Minister of Foreign Relations, ERRATIC has mentioned (Lic.) Auturo FERALTA, brother of (Guatemalan Military Attache to Washington, Colonel) Enrique FERALTA. He is very pro-American and a highly successful lawyer in Guatemala (Note: He is also attorney for Ibarra Hermanos, which is one of the wealthiest companies in Guatemala). He is self-made and of the middle class as is his brother. He is popular with all elements and classes. He has worked for a long time underground against the Communists but has always refused publicity and party affiliation so he could remain acceptable to everyone. He confidentially advised ERRATIC during his 1950 campaign for the presidency.
 2. As an alternate Minister of Foreign Relations there is (Lic.) Luis BELTRANENA Hijo. ERRATIC thinks highly of the son, but not of the father. The father is a very intelligent man but he is a loose talker and assumes many airs. He is from the old colonial aristocracy and this fact occasionally overcomes him. He simply is not

cautious. The son, however, is modest, able, and an excellent public speaker. He has the confidence and backing of the old families of Guatemala.

3. Colonel Auturo RAMIREZ is the best choice for Minister of Hacienda y Credito Republico. He was educated in the United States. In Guatemala in the past he has held the post of Minister of Agriculture and later Minister of Defense. He left office when URICO took control because he disliked his stern dictatorship. He predicted the Communist trend of the AREVALO Government and took part in the first plot against AREVALO, after which he was exiled to Costa Rica. He is now 57 years old and has an intimate knowledge of the sources of revenue and financial aspects of Guatemala.

5. ERRATIC never fails to mention in any serious conversation his appreciation of the problem of the campesinos. He stated, this time, the worst social problem in Guatemala is the drinking of the campesinos. He does not believe complete prohibition is a solution because he does not think it could be successfully accomplished. However, he believes it worthy of thought to contemplate shifting the campesino taste from Guaro or Aguardiente to Wine. Guaro is simply poison but the Indian will seize any excuse to drink it. The drinking of Guaro saps the essential energy of the country and poisons the people. ERRATIC said if wine were made available to them through Government measures, then there is a remote chance the campesino might be prevailed upon to change his habits. ERRATIC feels the change would be a good one since he has noted the difference between the people who drink wine and the Indian. The Chileans, Argentines, and others drink wine and profit from the vitamin and great food value. It builds them up rather than tears people down. It could be imported in bulk and distributed cheaply duty free. ERRATIC states the natives think Aguardiente is ambrosia or nectar from the gods. Many times he has seen a family walking through the woods. The father leads the procession and then comes the wife, sister, and children. After taking a long drink from the bottle he will then pass it down the line to the other members of the family until everyone has had a taste. Even the small children are given a little and babies' lips are wetted. He says it is possible to evaluate the effect a change to wine might make in this example alone. He feels eventually such a shift could well change the entire character of a powerful element in Guatemalan society and economy.

6. ERRATIC gave to JUVIA-2 six pages with a total of approximately fifty-five names of Communists in Guatemala which are attached hereto.

7. For the Minister of Agriculture ERRATIC would prefer Don Mamuel RALDA. He is a self-taught agronomist and ERRATIC has observed the past Ministers of Agriculture have always been divorced from reality and operated in theoretic confusion. The Ministry has never been of real help to the agriculturists because of the political hacks and theoretical students who have composed the Ministry and it has accordingly accomplished nothing. ERRATIC is very impressed with what Salvador has accomplished for its agriculturists and would like to do the same for Guatemala. The present Agriculture School in Guatemala passes its time in football, target practice, etc. A rough example to illustrate the ineffectiveness of that Ministry was indicated when ERRATIC was Governor of San Marcos. He was invited by the local Head of the Agricultural Station to make an inspection of some crops. ERRATIC arrived on horseback at 6:00 o'clock in the morning near the appointed meeting place. He stopped at a small store and asked precisely where he could find the man he was to meet. The woman told him to go through the nearby milpa fields until he came to the most stunted diseased milpa crop and it would be the one belonging to the school. He did so and found that the woman had spoken the truth. Another example is illustrated in that the main agricultural school to provide training in coffee growing is located at a 6000 foot altitude, whereas coffee only grows effectively up to an altitude of 4000 feet. RALDA is the same type as Roberto QUINONES of Salvador. ERRATIC desires outside technical aid and information. Presently the Agricultural Department has no central Information Bureau. Such a Bureau could be a great help. There has never been continuity in the crop planning although staple food must be in constant supply and must be subject to planning to meet future requirements. Under present conditions, one year may bring a tremendous crop with a low price, followed by a year with no crop at all and a consequently extremely high price. No advice is given farmers at present and the Agriculture Ministry is not even aware of the crops being grown, much less the estimated yield. A good example is the Guatemalan Germans who were growing cardian crops for several years without the Agriculture Ministry even being aware of it. When they finally found out they immediately levied very high taxes which precluded the growing of that crop at all. When ERRATIC was Governor of San Marcos he said he noticed the prevalence of head and body lice in various areas. DDT had not yet made its appearance on the market. He became apprised of a crop called piretro which could be used in pulverized and liquid form to combat lice. He immediately sent for information and started planting this crop as well as influencing others to cultivate it also. One day a Government Agent making his rounds claimed to know all about the crop and told him to discontinue it at once because it would ruin the soil. ERRATIC immediately wrote the countries which had been growing it for information regarding its effect on the soil and received replies stating it had no advice of adverse effect whatsoever. However, by that time, the planters were so discouraged by the agent that all cultivation of it had stopped and, as a result, the body lice returned in force, there being no deterrent.

8. A good prospect for the position of Minister of Public Education is Dr. Mariano Lopez ARABTA, a brother of Enrique Lopez ARABTA. This man is a prominent surgeon and well-fitted and qualified for the office. However, ERRATIC would not insist on any particular man because there are many able "professoras" (Women teachers) who perhaps might be even better qualified and would accept without demurring about the low salary involved.

9. For the Minister of Social Help and Assistance, ERRATIC merely states he thinks Dr. Mariano Lopez ARABTA well-qualified for this office.

10. For the Office of Chief Justice he would recommend Jesus Unda MURILLO highly.

11. Another big problem in Guatemala is to gain the confidence in all classes; to reunite the country; and to reunite the classes. The Communists have done great devastation in bringing class strife to the country. Men of intelligence are in need who can demonstrate to all classes that they understand particular problems and are doing something about them. The wealthy class as a whole has let all prestige and authority slip from their hands and display little or no interest. They are apathetic. The present government, of course, encourages this position and gloats that the wealthy class does nothing for the country. ERRATIC feels wealthy men should be encouraged to accept appointments. There are many intelligent, capable men in this class who have been well-trained and are ideal to represent their country abroad. They are naturally equipped; have been educated abroad; and understand the thinking abroad. The Government now calls the wealthy class "sampos" and claims they have no civic interest. ERRATIC feels he could prevail upon them to accept government office and positions and that they would do much for the Government and for the prestige of their people.

12. There is a Mexican now staying at the Nuevo Mundo Hotel who owns a number of ships operating in the Pacific. His name is Rafael Ramirez GUZMAN. He exports livestock from Nicaragua and has been exporting some from Salvador also. Because of a lack of available livestock here he is now leaving for Tapachula. GUZMAN was informed by (Cm) BONILLA, Minister of Nicaragua to Salvador (Note: Very pro-American and anti-Communist), that CALLIGERIS recently went to the United States and obtained more money from some source to continue his movement against Guatemala. GUZMAN's father is a godfather of ERRATIC. GUZMAN and ERRATIC went to military school together and ERRATIC is very close to both father and son. GUZMAN also said REFUS continually offers to do great deeds but never performs.

13. ERRATIC said one of his key men in the Guatemalan City Organization was Urbano MARTINEZ. He originates policy and also implements it. He may be reached through Marco Tulio PORRAS at the Imprenta El Imparcial.

14. ERRATIC discussed in more detail the plan of Jose Luis ARENAS. BARRERA stated the plan of ARENAS to pose as an anti-Communist and take refuge in the Salvadoran Embassy in Guatemala was well-known to the ERRATIC underground prior to the date the plan was put into action (Note: ARENAS took refuge 26 February 1954 while ERRATIC reported to JUVIA-2 that this was his intention on 25 February). ERRATIC reiterated his former charge that the man was a skilled, clever, Communist agent who was seeking to enter Salvador, ^{hostile to the current Guatemalan Government.} ERRATIC further pointed out the man was a member of the National Assembly and had no need for the sanctity of an Embassy. He said it has been well known to his underground for some time that not only was ARENAS definitely a Communist but also that (Colonel) Alberto FUNES, Salvadoran Ambassador to Guatemala, in whose Embassy ARENAS would take sanctity, was sympathetic and cooperative with Guatemalan Communists.
