Operational Matters  
KUFIRE Tasks, PBSUCCESS

1. Attached herewith are three (3) specific KUFIRE tasks for your priority development as indicated in each instance.

2. The symbols assigned each task will be used for the duration of this project in all cable or dispatch references disregarding previously assigned cryptonyms or project outlines. They will also be used in your monthly accounting summary for this project.

3. The attached is forwarded for purposes of general guidance and operational authority. Further and more specific details will be provided, task by task, as the situation develops and is warranted.

4. A "Weekly KUFIRE Operational Report" is to be submitted to LINCOLN, copy to Headquarters, which will reflect progress and effort expended in the development of each task. This report will be valuable to Project Headquarters to determine the situation in the field on a weekly basis. For your information, this Headquarters is obligated to provide an assessment of operational progress for higher echelons on or about 15 February 1954. It is contemplated that this assessment will be prepared from the above weekly reports and other data received during the period thus relieving the field of further special reporting at that time.

5. Your KUFIRE mission is primarily one of providing CE or protective intelligence for KUHOOK/KUCLUB operations in [ ] . It is important that this Project Headquarters be kept fully informed of all developments in your area of responsibility which have bearing on these sensitive operations whether Communist, official or other sources. In addition, it is incumbent upon you to provide secure cut-outs for establishing a means of communication between these isolated operations and this Headquarters.

6. Any operational activity of a KUFIRE nature which is not provided for in the attached list or that you would recommend for approval as a specific task in the future, should be forwarded by cable in a similar manner, indicating your estimated cost on a monthly basis. Upon approval by this Project Headquarters, a specific symbol would be assigned for identification and accounting purposes.

7. The estimated cost indicated in the attached list of tasks is for the period 1 January to 1 March 1954.
