



Current Notes EAST ASIA Japan: Tokyo Warns China That Nuclear Tests May Affect Aid During his recent visit to Beijing, Foreign Minister Kakizawa reminded his counterpart that Japanese aid guidelines require Tokyo to consider a nation's nonproliferation record in making aid decisions. Tokyo reinforced this point by delaying a trip by a Foreign Ministry delegation to discuss plans for grant aid and technical assistance Over the past year, Japanese officials have repeatedly told Washington and the Japanese public that they are taking the aid principles seriously. In the China's nuclear test last October drew similar tough talk from
