Memo No. 386 of 28th November, 1944 from 7408.

1. We have asked 7496's operator to acknowledge receipt of every message sent, but results have not been very satisfactory to date in spite of our numerous requests to this effect. We cannot, therefore, rely on obtaining regular and speedy confirmation of all messages received.

2. We have advised 7496 that Gothenburg wish for a guarantee that all messages relayed to him through H.Q. are received and have told him that we shall give him a crack signal in each such message to confirm receipt and have requested him to send back those crack signals immediately.

3. We shall advise you as soon as 7496 confirms that he agrees to this procedure.
