1. Messages from 7496 are usually received on the same day as originated by him - the delay between reception in this country and arrival at our H.Q. being anything up to one and a half hours. Thereafter the usual delays for Most Immediate Stockholm telegrams apply.
2. When crack signals are sent, their receipt at our H.Q. is only a matter of minutes.
3. We have advised 7496 that we require a minimum of 48 hrs. notice from the time of despatch of his signal, in order that we may give you timely information regarding the times and places of Clubs rendezvous.

P.S. It has happened on occasions that 7496's messages have been delayed in transmission at his end. We have pointed this out and have ordered the inclusion of the date of origin as well as serial number in every W/T message. Since this procedure came into force we have noted no delays between the originator and W/T operator.
