Scala informs me that some, if not all, of these men went to the American Consulate in your town and poured out their woes. It would appear that they were rather indiscreet in that they went into details as to why they had left the D.H.T.

2. The Americans have promised not to employ them.
3. What is the financial situation of these men? I should be glad to have your views as to whether we ought to pay any of them a monthly allowance.
