War Time Activities: 1936-1940 service with Abt. I M of the
Amt Ausland/Abwehr of the OKW in the
following capacities:

June 1940 - Referent on Naval
Construction and Administration, Abwehr IM

1 July 1940 - Dec 1942, Naval Attache,
Istanbul, Athens, Sofia, remained a member
of the Abwehr.

1943 left Abwehr. Head of Reichskriegs-
ariat fuer die Schifffahrt in Greece
with HQ in Athens.

Jan 44 - 10 Nov. 1944, 1st Officer on
cruiser "Koslos". Taken off ship at Oslo
as suspected member of Anti-Nazi group
trying to arrange a peace abroad. Known
to be closely connected with [unclear]
involved in July 20 affair. Imprisoned
at Buchenwald, Dachau and Innsbruck.

Party Affiliation: Subject was never a member of the NSDAP.
