Subject: Organization Chart for Central Intelligence Group

1. Attached for your information is a copy of the current organization chart for the Central Intelligence Group.

2. After consultation with Mr. Buford and his expression of the State Department's desires, 21 key positions within this organization will normally be reserved for assignment of individuals selected by and detailed from the State Department for duty with the Central Intelligence Group. It is understood that such individuals will be retained on State Department rolls and may be rotated from time to time on a plan which will not disrupt the continuity of Central Intelligence Group operations. The figure of 21 given above may be reduced or may be increased to a total of 26 at your discretion.
