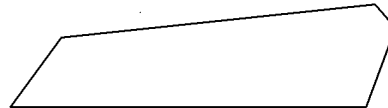

During my service in the army I was awarded the Good Conduct Medal, Jump Wings, Combat Infantry Badge, Vietnam Service Medal, Vietnam Campaign ribbon with 5 clasps, the Army Commendation Medal with one oak leaf cluster, and the Bronze Star Medal with one oak leaf cluster. During my 5 1/2 years of army service, 44 months were spent in the Asian theater of operations. Upon being discharged from the army, I did not seek employment in the states because it was my desire to return to Asia to work. I feel that my command time in the army qualifies me for administrative type work, and my previous experience in the 1st Special Forces Group working with indigenous personnel from most parts of Asia will be extremely valuable in any position / operation involving indigenous personnel. I held a secret security clearance from Oct 1966 until my DISCHARGE IN JULY 1969.
