The office of the Information and Privacy Coordinator received (on 22 February 2006) your 3 February 2006 Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request for the 2005 CIA Inspector General report, Accountability with **Respect to the 9/11 Attacks.** We have assigned your request the reference number above.
