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3. a. Guard Unit (Wachkommando) -- Re-designated "Hundstreich 2.b.V." (Company for Special Purposes). Its chief, Richard Stockmann, was then promoted to Oberkommissar.
- b. Border and Security Police (Grenzpolizei und Grenzschutz -- Hauptabteilung SP/3) -- Located in a building on Gorkenstrasse, Berlin-Mitte, which was recently visited by the Kriminaltechnisches Institut (ITI). Only the photo section of the KMP has been left behind.
- c. Schools and Training (Hauptabteilung Schulung) -- The Advanced Police School was moved from Berlin-Lichterfelde into the former army barracks in Köpenick, Berlin-Südost, Saxony-Anhalt.
- d. Administrative Police (Verwaltungspolizei) -- There has been a further reduction in the responsibilities of Abteilung VP. The Traffic Branch (Verkehrsabteilung) has been re-activated under Heinkel, who was promoted from Referent to branch chief.

Section 4 -- Motorized Equipment (Kraftfahrwesen).
Chief: A former German officer, recently released from a Soviet PW Camp.

Section 5 -- Signals. This section formerly belonged to the Uniformed Constabulary Branch (Pamtsabteilung S). Signals is in charge of technical organization and procurement of signal supplies.

Personalities:

Dr. Diefenbach of the Administrative Police has been succeeded by Dr. Schöppe as official in charge of the issue of passes and of registration procedures. Schöppe, who claims to hold a doctorate both in medicine and philology, has graduated from an "anti-fascist" indoctrination school in Soviet Russia. He has been described as a man with an exaggerated notion of his own importance.

Dr. Ernst, the head of the Administrative Services Unit in Berlin, is said to be a "who Communist".

Oberpolizeirat Jank, until recently chief of the Fahrbereitschaft (patrol car task force), and was been relieved of his duties, reduced to Oberkommissar and transferred to Schools and Training.
