The Pan Africanist Congress (PAC) in London has agreed not to participate in either the Vietnam Solidarity Campaign or the Bertrand Russell-sponsored War Crimes Tribunal. [redacted] claimed that the PAC had made this decision as a result of pressures brought upon London PAC members by himself and Ebrahim, Assistant Representative of the PAC in London. Barney Desai and Kenny Jordan had earlier made an agreement with the Vietnam Solidarity Campaign to participate without the knowledge of Ebrahim.

1. [redacted] Comment Recently published literature of the Vietnam Solidarity Campaign still lists the PAC among sponsoring organizations.
2. [redacted] Comment According to [redacted] indicated in mid-September 1966 that Barney Desai and Kenny Jordan, both former members of the South African Colored Peoples Congress (CPC), were then active within a dissident group of the PAC in London which was seeking to oust Potlako K. Mabalo as Acting President of the PAC.
