According to a [redacted], a Soviet naval officer [redacted] to Leningrad [redacted] stated that he had gone / in 1957 on a government commission for the acceptance of a serial atomic submarine (odnorednaya atomnaya podvodnaya lodka). The [redacted] stated that since the submarine was one of a series, it was not the first Soviet atomic submarine, but one of a number in series production.

[redacted] stated that the USSR had been building atomic submarines for some time (uzhe davno). The naval officer concerned was an engineering officer.

Source Comment: Ocherednaya is the equivalent of v serii. The function of the acceptance commission is to examine the submarine, observe tests of the submarine, and sign certifications regarding the submarine.
