Dear Mr. Smathers:

This is a final response to your undated (postmarked 4 October 2010) Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request, received in the office of the Information and Privacy Coordinator on 13 October 2010, for **“an index, catalog or log of all organizations which the CIA’s Political Islam Strategic Analysis Program (PISAP) has any threat assessments, reports, or other intelligence collected on.”**

We have completed a thorough review of your request and have determined that our record systems are not configured in a way that would allow us to perform a search reasonably calculated to lead to responsive records without an unreasonable effort. The FOIA does not require federal agencies to perform research, create records or conduct unreasonable searches through a body of material to see if any of it is related to a particular request. Therefore, we must decline to process your request.
