1. Attached is a draft of an agreement reached 19 June 1958 between the Agency and [redacted] attorney at law, will sign for us on behalf of undisclosed principles, and [redacted] will sign for [redacted] It is planned to execute the agreement on 23 June 1958.

2. The draft has been approved by [redacted] of OGC. Paragraph 10 may be somewhat difficult to administer, but it was the judgement of our negotiators that it was necessary to include this [redacted] amount in order to get [redacted] to accept the agreement.

3. [redacted] will get in touch with us in about ten days in connection with negotiating the second phase having to do with publication in Europe from the proofs which will be delivered under this contract. [redacted] will handle the business and accounting details and will be compensated on a fee basis from project funds. [redacted] has informed Central Cover Branch of the above arrangements.

✓ 6. It is understood and agreed that the undersigned hereby retains all right, title and interest in and to the said literary work and manuscript and said manuscript shall be returned to the undersigned upon completion of the work.

✓ 7. You further agree that the material and all rights therein furnished by you hereunder shall become the sole property of the undersigned and shall be delivered to the undersigned or stored, as directed by the undersigned, and if so stored the undersigned shall pay any storage charges.

8. Payment for such material shall be made to you against your invoice and at the cost charged to you by your suppliers and you agree to furnish to, or permit the inspection by the undersigned of your suppliers' invoices. The undersigned, however, agrees, at your request, to advance to you such sums not exceeding a total of as and when needed by you, but in such event you shall on or before July 31, 1958 furnish detailed invoices from your suppliers of your actual cost incurred and repay any excess advanced.

9. As full compensation for your services and upon completion of the material agreed to be furnished in accordance with the above described time schedule, the undersigned agrees to pay to you a fee in the sum of and an additional fee of for each 24 hours of earlier completion.

10. You further undertake to investigate with reputable and qualified publishing concerns in and other countries approved by the undersigned the making of arrangements for the printing, binding, publishing and distribution of "Dr. Zhivago" and to report to the undersigned the terms and conditions, if any, upon

which any such firm will undertake such responsibility. For such services the undersigned agrees to pay you the sum of plus any telephone, cable or oil charges incurred by you in the performance of such services.

11 You understand and agree that the undersigned is acting as agent for certain undisclosed principals but the undersigned represents and warrants that he will be personally responsible for the payment of the sums herein contracted to be paid.

Gentlemen:

The following constitutes our agreement

1. You hereby acknowledge receipt from the undersigned of a manuscript copy of a literary work entitled "Dr. Zhivago" by Boris Pasternak.

2. The undersigned will further furnish you with type copy of a "publishers' note" or preface to be included after the title page of said manuscript.

3. You agree to procure and furnish to the undersigned, the following:

(a) Necessary layout and design work to prepare the manuscript including title page and preface for type set.

(b) Proofread type setting in the Russian language of said manuscript in page size 5 1/2" x 8 1/2". Such type setting to be 23 picas wide and 30 lines long, including folios.

(c) 2 sets of photo offset reproduction proofs of said page type settings of good quality and capable of providing clear and legible offset reproductions.

4. You agree that all of the foregoing work will be of high quality and shall be completed not later than 12:00 Midnight July 31, 1958.

5. You further undertake and agree that the maximum cost to the undersigned of the components above described shall not exceed the following:
