### 1. Malaysia

a. Prime Minister Rahman announced last night that Malaysia was severing diplomatic relations with Indonesia and the Philippines.

d. Sukarno had earlier suggested that the next Maphilindo summit meeting be held next month in Kuala Lumpur, This would now seem impossible except in the unlikely event that Djakarta agrees to recognize Malaysia.

### NOTES

- Communist China Hong Kong Peiping's net trade Α. earnings from Hong Kong could reach \$260 million this year, \$60 million more than 1962, primarily because the Chinese have been pushing exports of vegetables, livestock and poultry. This and developments in Sino-Soviet relations are reviving foreign business interest in the "Chinese market," but Peiping seems in no hurry to buy. A good part of the money will be needed to pay for continuing grain imports.
- Cuba-USSR B. Havana radio says 1,828 "young Cuban peasants" have completed their studies in the USSR and will return to Cuba shortly after spending a week in Moscow as guests of the Soviet youth organization.
- The new Conservative-led minority coalition C. Norway government may already be in for trouble. The Labor Party has some hope of overthrowing it on a no-confidence motion following parliamentary debate, which begins today, on the government's program.
