Reference: MCR-W-883L

1. Subject of reference communication is CAUTERY 6, who served us in a transient capacity as purveyor of operational leads. He is no longer in Berlin.

2. Of the leads he provided, one materialized. Upon CAUTERY 6's recommendation, we recruited CAUTERY 8.

3. CAUTERY 6 has expressed a desire to return to Berlin as soon as his family is settled in the West Zone. He wants to work for us and stated that he is prepared to undertake assignments in the East Zone. Inasmuch as the lack of Russian speakers in that capacity constitutes one of our major operational bottlenecks, we propose to take CAUTERY 6 up on his proposition, should it be repeated.

4. No further biographical data (FRQ's, etc.) will be submitted on CAUTERY 6, inasmuch as his current usefulness has been fully exploited.

5. Subject's preliminary interrogation was conducted by [redacted] under Provost Marshal cover. CAUTERY 6 was almost immediately turned over to CAUTERY 2. He knows both CAUTERY 2 and 4 under their false names. The identity of the American organization back of CAUTERY is not known to Subject. In order to keep in touch with CAUTERY, he has been provided with a letter-drop in Berlin (P.O. box).
