- 1. On 7 June 1960, loaned la photograce clipped from the Paris edition of the Herald Tribune (paper la photograph undated, but datelines are 30 May 1960) showing Tuvia FRI DMANN, chief of the documentation center on Mazi war carines in Haifa, and liming him to israeli intelligence. Inoted that FRITHAM Lad had no role in activities. He described him as dedicated but a bit unbalanced as the result of his concentration camp experience.
- 2. On 6 June, the OTACID chief from Haifa had reported that PRITIMANN had applied for a visa, and that Trew Pearson and others were pressing for queck issuance so that FRITDMANN could appear in television, revies, etc., in connection with his role in the TICHTANN case. (He played no role whatseever - Issuance was delayed however by the fact that an anonymous letter had been received stating PRIFIT all had served in the UP.
- months in 1965, and then in 1946 had gone to Vienna where he served in the illegal immigration under "Artur" (Arthur NEN-NATAN, new Pirreter-General of the Ministry of Referce). that Fill Alvis service in the UB had no hearing on his security. against the Mazis, and that there was no security reason for denying FRIEDMANN a visa.
- nertioned the MAVARTV interview at conference, where it was viewed as an impediment 1. in Same to quick compliance with free Pearson's wishes. Then specifically repeated the information to the lesponsible for such matters. Inoted the overt nature of official the information, and asked that he not be involved in the matter.
- 5. The official stated that under the law FRITDMANN was disqualified from receiving a visa, and added that he would get a translation of the newspaper item, and inform the OPACIF chief in Haifa. If the translation of the clipping is received, it will be forwarded HQS as an attachment to this report.
