1. Subject, a Polish citizen, has a record of virulent anti-semitism and collaboration with the Nazis before and during World War II. After the war, he opportunistically turned to Moscow and communism.

2. Subject is now Chief, PAX in Poland, a Communist Catholic organization established by the Russians to confuse and undermine Catholic elements inside and outside of the government. He has become wealthy as a result of many lucrative PAX enterprises.

3. A reliable source has informed us that Subject has become very apprehensive of EICHMANN, who might reveal Subject's background and jeopardize his favored position.

4. We would appreciate receiving either now or in the future any derogatory information on Subject which you may be able to get out of EICHMANN.
