ORWETER gave James an excerpt of one or two chapters which he said describe in some detail DOLLMANN's wartime experiences and contacts with the Americans in Italy, and which he requested James or his people. examine for content "which might possibly be offensive to the United States." He stressed the fact that DOLLMANN was so anxious not to offend his great good friend ASCHAM (with whom he allegedly had contact during WW II), that he had several months ago forwarded identical excerpts from this book to Mr. Eisenhower for executive comment, but that strangely enough to date he had received no reply. James expects to take no action other than a courteous reply to the effect that such advice is outside the State Department's province.

- The last word POB has received on the DOLIMANN/HUNGER matter was in Twherein COM expressed intention of taking no action until they received word from Washington.


