This also acknowledges your 20 July 2015 letter, received on 27 July 2015. We have assigned your request the reference number above. Please use this number when corresponding, so we can identify it easily.

The FOIA requires requesters to "reasonably describe" the information they seek so that professional employees familiar with the subject matter can locate responsive information with a reasonable amount of effort. Commonly this equates to a requirement that the documents must be locatable through the indexing of our various systems. Extremely broad or vague requests or requests requiring research do not satisfy this requirement. We require requesters seeking any form of "electronic communications" such as emails, to provide the specific "to" and "from" recipients, time frame and subject. We note that in each of the six subjects above, you have only provided one recipient. Therefore, we must decline your request.
