MEMORANDUM

SUBJECT: Organizational Chart of the German Security Service Headquarters in the Netherlands, 1945

1. Examination of German documents captured during World War II has produced an organizational chart of the headquarters of the Commandant of the Security Service for the Netherlands (BdS Niederlande). The chart was dated 15 March 1945 and included the name of FELFE as deputy chief of Department VI-Enschede. The documents were originally held at the captured WW II records repository in Alexandria, Virginia (now the Federal Records Center); they have since been microfilmed and returned to the Bonn Government. The microfilms are currently held in Washington by the National Archives where they may be examined by referring to document number EAP - VIII - 173 - c - 10 - 14/51. Reproductions of the pertinent pages are attached.
2. Although the chart contained the last names of the principal personnel of BdS Niederlande, other identifying data were not recorded. However, a search of other pertinent captured German documents has brought to light biographic data as follows:
