1. It is felt that any POB-directed effort to penetrate ZIPPER is more dangerous than its potential value can justify, particularly at this stage.

2. The Zipperite mentioned in para 1 of reference is the leader of a UV. An old and sick man, he has himself been repeatedly guilty of the insecurity which he not attributes to his headquarters. This lack of security has drawn down upon his head the wrath of both the POB case officer concerned and the ZIPPER headquarters operations office. His remarks to the teacher are merely the mutterings of a man who is chronically ill and who is trying to attribute his sins to others. Incidentally, his immediate headquarters has been gradually restricting the scope of this man's work for several months, and he is undoubtedly resentful as well.

3. The teacher mentioned in reference may be part of a Zipper operation directed by the man discussed above. See para 6 of MGLA-5558 (not to BOB). In any case, since the teacher has several ZIPPER friends, POB could never be sure that he would not function as a two-way street.
