<p>a. CAROAST-3: Subject is a 63 year old German National employed as the registrar of a local educational institute attended by several hundred foreign students. He was recruited as an unwitting reporting source by CAPEDAL-1 in December 1958. OA for use of Subject as an unwitting source was granted by ERM-8491, 22 December 1959. CAROAST-3 furnishes MOB with a student list twice a year; he is paid for the list. He also furnishes, without charge, information about students in response to specific requests.</p>			
<p>6. Since unwitting sources of information, such as CAROAST-2 and CAROAST-3, are not fully controlled KUBARK agents, the possibility of security problems arising must be recognized. This possibility, however, constitutes a minimal risk for the following reasons:</p> <p>a. Disclosure of their activities would, in most instances, be more damaging to our unwitting sources than it would be to MOB. As a typical case, CAROAST-3 would certainly lose his position were it to become known to the school administration that he has, in effect, been accepting bribes and disclosing official information without authorization.</p>
