- 5. Another group which has aligned itself enthusiastically with this conspiracy is the Accion Revolucionaria Guiteras (ARG). The leaders of this group, Eufemio Fernandez Ortega and Jesus Gonzalez Cartas ("El Extrano"), are in Guatemala, reportedly in close contact with Sanchez Arango.
- 6. Carlos Prio Socarras is contributing \$20,000 a month to take care of the initial preparation expenses, and he will increase this sum whenever such increase is necessary to obtain the eventual success of the conspiracy.
