1. On 29 September 1953, Robert H. HEILBROWN of the HICOG General Counsel staff (naturalized US citizen of German origin) gave me a copy of the attached note (photostats attached) from Judge Dr. LORENTZEN of the Landgericht Wiesbaden, requesting HICOG's permission to have General GEHLEN and Tommy HEZEMANS appear as witnesses in the trial of the State against Hellmut KILLOH. - *counsel for the defense of Gen ELAND - Duke Chen - accused of extortion + blackmail.*
2. HEZEMANS, a Dutch citizen, was formerly with ODI HICOG in Wiesbaden and is now employed with MSA (FOA) HICOG. During the ELAND trial HICOG received the same request regarding HEZEMANS and at that time I counseled against permitting HEZEMANS to appear as a witness. I repeated the same counsel, and HEILBROWN said that in any case HEZEMANS would not be permitted to testify.
3. Concerning GEHLEN, I told HEILBROWN that he was not a US employee and therefore outside HICOG jurisdiction. HEILBROWN also mentioned that the Germans had asked him for the address of GEHLEN and I told him that I did not know anything about his whereabouts. HEILBROWN said he would inform Judge LORENTZEN that HICOG had no information on GEHLEN.
