1. Forwarded herewith is the psychiatrist's report on the examination of [REDACTED]. The psychiatrist feels that the examination was the most successful of the three which were conducted at [REDACTED]. An excellent phantasy situation was created, and it is the opinion of the [REDACTED] interrogator, as well as that of the psychiatrist, that the results of the examination show that [REDACTED] is clean with us on this operation, and that he has a genuine fear that if the [REDACTED] ever finds out he is in contact with the AIS, it will mean ruin for him and for his son.

2. The psychiatrist cautioned us firmly that in [REDACTED] case we should not attach too much significance to discrepancies in times and places. The psychiatrist does not believe that such discrepancies are due to attempts at deception by [REDACTED], but that [REDACTED] is a person who is genuinely uninterested in such details in his past, and this lack of interest leads to difficulty in recalling such facts with exactitude. [REDACTED] interest in life is in people rather than in circumstances of time and place.

3. A full report will be forwarded when [REDACTED] has a chance to transcribe the tapes.

4. It is requested that a copy of the attachment be given to [REDACTED] and a copy to the [REDACTED] medical department.
