I - AWARD OF BRONZE STAR MEDAL

By direction of the President, under the provisions of Army Regulations 600-45, as amended, the Bronze Star Medal was awarded by the Theater Commander to the following named personnel:

ARTHUR B. BORDER, 0374865, Major (then Captain) Field Artillery, Company D, 2677th Regiment, Office of Strategic Services, for meritorious achievement in connection with military operations in Italy from 20 October 1944 to 8 May 1945. Entered service from Rosendale, Massachusetts.

SCOTT R. DICKINSON, 0345792, Major, Ordnance, Headquarters, 2677th Regiment, Office of Strategic Services, for heroic achievement in connection with military operations against the enemy in Jugoslavia from 23 June 1944 to 12 May 1945. Entered service from Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania.
